



Canadian Union of Public Employees Local 622 Scholarship Maple Ridge Pitt Meadows Municipal Employees

C.U.P.E. Local 622 offers 2 - \$1000 scholarships to children or step-child of a member of C.U.P.E. Local 622 (Maple Ridge/Pitt Meadows). If no application is received from a child or step-child, then the grandchild, niece or nephew may be eligible.

One \$1000 scholarship is given for Academic achievement and one \$1000 scholarship is given for Vocational achievement (a student who shows initiative, promise and desire to succeed in their chosen career).

1. Requirements:

a) Applicant must be a child or stepchild of a Member of Local 622 or a member of Local 622. If no applications are received, then grandchildren, nieces, or nephews of a member of Local 622 may be eligible.

b) Applicant must be in grade 12.

c) The student must plan further education or training in the academic, vocational field, trade schooling or apprenticeship trade.

d) Payment of bursary issued on proof of registration or receipt of enrolment in any post secondary education up to 24 months afterward or other proof acceptable to the scholarship committee of C.U.P.E. Local 622.

2. Application:

a) Provide a brief letter outlining how your education, work experience and or volunteering provides an opportunity for success in your chosen program, career or occupation. Letters of reference may be an asset in determining your qualification for the bursary.

b) You must use an application form provided by C.U.P.E. local 622. Application forms will be available February 1. No financial information is required. Information should include transcript of marks for grade 11 & 12, name of Local 622 member and your relationship.

c) Applications are to be submitted directly to C.U.P.E. 622 by April 1.
